

## COVID-19 Pre-entry Screening Questionnaire (Layer 1)

This questionnaire must be answered by all Rio Tinto employees and contractors before mobilising to their workplace and before other screening processes at the airport, office or site gate entry.

<p>1. Have you entered Western Australia in the past 14 days?</p> <p><b>If YES, refer to below actions.</b></p> <p><i>(* Note: If Yes, <u>AND</u> you are considered a Specialised Role, you must have written approval from a Rio Tinto Managing Director (MD) before travelling to site)</i></p>		
<p>2. Within the last 24 hours:</p> <p>have you had symptoms of a fever (for example night sweats or chills) or had a raised temperature (<math>\geq 37.5^{\circ}\text{C}</math>)</p> <p><b>OR</b></p> <p>had acute respiratory symptoms (for example a cough, shortness of breath or a sore throat)</p> <p><b>If YES, refer to below actions.</b></p>		
<p>3. Have you been in close contact* with someone who is currently a confirmed or probable case of COVID-19?</p> <p><i>*Close contact is defined as being face-to-face contact in any setting with a confirmed or probable case, for greater than 15 minutes cumulative over the course of a week, in the period extending from 48 hours before onset of symptoms in the confirmed or probable case, <b>OR</b> sharing of a closed space with a confirmed or probable case for a prolonged period (e.g. more than 2 hours) in the period extending from 48 hours before onset of symptoms in the confirmed or probable case.</i></p> <p><b>If YES, refer to below actions.</b></p>		
<p>4. Have you been diagnosed with and still having treatment* for COVID-19?</p> <p><i>(*Note: If you have completed treatment for COVID-19 and been cleared fit to return to work, then you will be required to provide medical documentation to confirm this).</i></p> <p><b>If YES, refer to below actions.</b></p>		

**If you have answered YES to ANY of the above:** Contact your leader or Rio Tinto representative who will then follow the COVID-19 Case Management for Leaders process. Please do not proceed to access a Rio Tinto Operation via the airport, airport gate, site gate entry or office.

**If you have completed treatment for COVID-19** and been cleared for work by your company Injury Management Advisor (IMA) you must bring all of your medical documentation confirming your clearance for work **each time** you are screened. Please proceed to your departure airport or Rio Tinto operation. Please note you will be subject to further screening.

**If you answered NO to ALL of the above** then present to designated screening areas and undertake additional screening measure when requested. These may vary depending on what type of operation / office you are accessing but may include:

- Temperature screening (Layer 2)
- COVID-19 POCT and/or PCR screening (Layer 3)

**Note:** COVID-19 POCT screening involves a very small blood sample (approx. 2ml) to be taken via a painless, finger pin-prick. If you have a medical condition that may prevent you from providing this sample i.e. it is a risk to your health or the health of others, please inform your Leader prior to presenting for this screen. Your leader will then liaise with the Injury Management team to determine if further assessment is necessary.
