

URGENT - Coronavirus (COVID-19) questionnaire

Please read this important update below from Bright Group’s Management Team.

Travel restrictions to Western Australia is subject to continuous change due to coronavirus outbreaks in other States. We request employees to keep abreast of the changing circumstances and how this may affect you. Bright Group’s primary focus is ensuring a safe and healthy work environment for all of our people.

TRAVEL: ALL PASSENGERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS ON DOMESTIC AIRCRAFT AND IN AIRPORTS.

Perth/Peel Region - Interim restrictions will be in place until 12:01am, Tuesday 6 July as part of a safe transition out of lockdown. Masks are still required to be worn indoors, outdoors and on public transport.

From 12:01am on 6th July, eased transitional restrictions will apply. Masks to be worn indoors, including the workplace and public transport. No intrastate travel restrictions

Mandatory Questionnaire for travel to sites for Bright Group Employees

If you are experiencing any flu like symptoms, regardless of your travel history, **do not travel to site**. Get in touch with your GP and Bright Group contact before returning to any Bright Group sites or office. This includes post-recovery from the flu – do not return to work until you are fully recovered from all flu symptoms.

Employees travelling to site for mining companies - please familiarise yourself with the site containment measures and adhere to travel screening procedures. Interstate employees are required to familiarise themselves with the WA border controls and the border controls of their respective states. It is an employee’s responsibility to ensure you do not have a requirement to self-isolate or quarantine and that you are not displaying flu-like symptoms refraining you from travelling to site.
